# WHO WE ARE?

Ampelos Italia was founded in 2004 by a group of agronomists and food technologists with the aim of carrying out agri-food, educational and health development projects.

AMPELOS LUXEMBOURG was established in December 2021 by two luxembourg based Ampelos Italia partners and a group of friends and professional united by the desire to apply their skills in international cooperation projects that tackle concrete needs with the help of active and reliable local partners.

Sectors of intervention of the projects carried out over the years: Agribusiness, Water, Education, Health, Emergencies.

# **PROTEIN COOKIES**



In collaboration with Bunpa (Burundi Nutritious Pastries), an NGO set up to fight malnutrition and poverty in Burundi, WE LAUNCHED A LOCAL PRODUCTION of a protein biscuit specifically developed to meet the nutritional needs of Burundian children, whose malnutrition rate is among the highest in the world.

The ingredients for this super-biscuit are easily available locally: wheat flour, soy flour, peanuts, vegetable oil, cane sugar, milk, eggs, and yeast (the protein amount equates to 15% of the biscuit).

During 2024 we plan to implement a semi-industrial manufacturing process that would enable us to increase production quantities and reach a higher number of people.

## THREE ANGELS

Three Angels is a medical center located in Kator, one of the poorest district in the city of Juba.

In 2015, the local diocese provided the nuns of Kator with land plot where a small temporary medical center was set up, with a catchment population of 30.000. People started using the facility immediately and the number of patients has increased year after year.

# WATER WELLS

In collaboration with the St John Integral Education Centre and Ampelos Italia, we are continuing the construction of water wells, in the Mangochi area, ensuring drinkable water to 1800 families and 3 primary schools, for a total of 20,000 beneficiaries.

The objective is to provide drinking water at a reasonable distance from homes, preventing waterborne diseases, linked to consumption of contaminated streams and lakes (such as that from the lake) but also residents from traveling long distances every day to access water.

Currently, the first 5 wells have been completed\*
